Loop bus service launched in Sri Lanka capital

Sri Lanka Transport Board today launched a new city service across major towns in Sri Lanka's capital city of Colombo.

The bus service starts from Colombo Fort and loops back to the same spot via Pettah, Maradana, Borella, Narahenpita, Kirulapona, Havelock Town, and Town Hall covering a distance of 12 km. The buses take 30 minutes to cover the route.

The buses charge a fixed even fare of Rs. 10 from point to point.

Sri Lanka Transport Board said the new bus service would operate daily from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
